Prevention of Scarlet Fever

The local activity of seasonal Influenza has continued to increase in the past few weeks, a thorough cleaning has been done immediately in school. Recently, primary students suffered from "upper respiratory tract" and "gastrointestinal tract infection" syndrome symptoms. School would like to inform parents that a student has been confirmed to suffer from "Scarlet Fever". The bacteria are present in the mouth, throat and nose of the infected person. They are transmitted through either respiratory droplets or direct contact with infected respiratory secretions.

Parents are advised to monitor children's health condition closely.

- Children suffering from scarlet fever should refrain from attending school or child care setting until fever has subsided and they have been treated with antibiotics for at least 24 hours.
- Parents / Guardians must record the body temperature of their children in the following form, which should be handed in to school for inspection.
- Cover your nose and mouth while sneezing or coughing and dispose of nasal and mouth discharge properly.
